Friesan Fire was hot in March, with progeny winning all over the mid-Atlantic. Maryland's leading Active Sire, Friesan Fire was represented by the following winners:

**Friesani**, who broke her maiden on 3/3 for Country Life and partners in the Ma & Pa LLC; **Ethan's Escapades**, a winner at first asking on 3/25 for owner/breeder Lou Rao's La Bella Vita Farm (the chestnut gelding is a Merryland training graduate who transferred to trainer Lacey Gaudet's barn in January); **Blazin Luck**, who won an Allowance Race on 3/25 at Charles Town for owner/breeder Carisa Figgins; **Awsome Faith**; winner of another Allowance race at Charles Town to give him 2 wins and a 3rd in four starts this year; **Flaming Humor**, won for the 4th time in his career and is out of the stakes-producing Distorted Humor mare Final Humor; and **Helgoland**, who picked up his 5th career win at Charles Town and has been on the board in all 5 of his starts in 2017.

## FREEDOM CHILD GETS SOME PRESS!

Freedom Child is represented by 36 two-year-olds who are in the hands of trainers like Phil Schoenthal, Bernie Houghton, Ferris Allen and John Salzman.

Sire of FARRELL, winner of the \$400,000 Fair Grounds Oaks, Gr. 2, now favorite for the \$1-million dollar Kentucky Oaks, Gr. 1; and GORMLEY, on the Kentucky Derby trail and entered in the Gr. 1 Santa Anita Derby on 4/8.

Malibu Moon is also the broodmare sire of GIRVIN, winner of the \$1-million Louisiana Derby, Gr. 2, and a top contender for the \$2-million Kentucky Derby, Gr. 1. Malibu Moon is ranked No. 6, just behind Tapit, on the General Sire list (thru 4/5).

Congratulations to partners in the Ma & Pa LLC on Friesani's maiden win on March 3rd! Trained by Mike Trombetta and ridden by Julian Pimentel, the PA-bred filly by Friesan Fire out of Avani Force drew away to win by 3-3/4 lengths in the 1-1/16 mile event. She now has a win, a 2nd and a 3rd in seven starts with earnings of \$38,752.
