Into Bluegrass Takes Turf Season Debut!

Country Life racing partnership filly Into Bluegrass returned to the winner's circle on 4/18 in her second start after more than a year off. It was the first turf race of the season at Laurel, and the daughter of Into Mischief loved the fresh, smooth lawn.

She drew off in the stretch to earn her 2nd career win in the 5-1/2 furlong sprint, thanks to the KY Derby-bound duo of trainer Mike Trombetta and jockey Julian Pimentel! The filly has been on the board in 6 of her 10 starts so far.

Into Bluegrass takes the Laurel turf season opener!

Country Life stallions sired a slew of winners recently. Among the notables were maiden winners Fire Marshal (Friesan Fire) at Laurel and his half-brother, first time starter Ace Nine Nine (Super Ninety Nine) at Parx. The two horses are out of the retired stakes producer Smash Review, by Bates Motel. The mare also produced the multiple stakes winner and twice G3-placed American Dubai, who has earnings of over \$469,000 to date. Both Fire Marshal and Ace Nine Nine were bred by Country Life Farm.

Freedom Child runners are tearing up the track as well, and he sired a very rare Trifecta when his sons Confessor, Nico Bree N Teej and Hall Pass finished 1-2-3 in a Laurel Allowance on 4/7! His daughter Parisian Diva is 2-for-2 so far this year at Charles Town, after winning an allowance and the Its Been Too Long Stakes this month.
