New Partnerships for Mares from Keeneland -----SOLD OUT-----

The two mares we purchased at Keeneland last week --- 9-year-old REAL GOOD TIME (for \$33,000), in foal to Constitution, and 9-year-old SISTER STATE (for \$40,000), an A. P. Indy mare in foal to Champion Midshipman --- sold out quickly.

At no markup from public auction, the two mares were offered individually in

5-share LLC's. Country Life took the first 20% interest, to be an equal partner with our broodmare investors. A 20% share in REAL GOOD TIME cost \$6,600; a 20% share in SISTER STATE cost \$8,000.

Mares of such quality as REAL GOOD TIME and SISTER STATE are the key to the production of well-bred Maryland foals in coming years. The market's dramatic shift toward the higher-end mares means that all breeders will have to upgrade their inventory. Imagine the top stables that will race in Maryland once the proposed \$400-million improvements are made to Pimlico and Laurel. We better have well-bred foals in the pipeline to compete.

Maryland Million Weekend Fun

The 30th Anniversary running of the Maryland Million took place on Oct. 19, and Country Life stallion Friesan Fire sired the Classic winner for the second consecutive year.

In 2018, Saratoga Bob took the \$150,000 main event. This year, Forest Fire triumphed. The 4-year-old Pennsylvania-bred gelding, bred and owned by Shirley Lojeski, was coming off of two allowance wins at Parx. He stalked the leader to the top of the stretch, went to the front, and crossed the wire a half-length winner.

Earlier on the card, a son of former Country Life stallion Cal Nation named Ournationonparade, who was foaled here on the farm for breeder Jay Williamson, broke his maiden in the \$100,000 Maryland Million Nursery Stakes for 2-year-olds.

Partnership 2-year-old filly Bella Aurora won again at Laurel on Nov. 2nd, this time switching to dirt and going long for the first time. After placing in the \$100,000 Jamestown Stakes and Anne Arundel County Stakes on the turf, she handled the change in surface and distance, drawing off to an easy 3-length win with Julian Pimentel in the irons.

Trainer Mike Trombetta is eyeing the \$100,000 Gin Talking Stakes for her next start on December 28th. Her earnings stand at \$85,000 in 5 starts.
