We came home from a week of broodmare shopping at the Keeneland November Mixed Sale with a perfect fit for the Maryland-Bred Awards program: A valuable young mare named WAR VALUE.

We paid \$35,000 for this daughter of War Front, in foal to Florida Derby winner Known Agenda (a first-year son of Curlin at Spendthrift who covered 166 mares last spring). This was WAR VALUE's second trip through the Keeneland ring. The first time, she went for \$600,000 when sold as a yearling to St. Elias Stable. For trainer Todd Pletcher, War Value broke her maiden on the dirt at Saratoga by nine lengths. Her speed figure of "10" in that Saratoga Maiden Special event was evidence of her natural ability.

St. Elias won the Kentucky Derby in 2016 with Always Dreaming. They have bred WAR VALUE twice to their Derby winner. In between, WAR VALUE was bred to popular Candy Ride sire TWIRLING CANDY. Her 2021 colt by him brought \$85,000 at this year's Fasig Tipton Kentucky October Yearling sale:



In 2022, St. Elias sent WAR VALUE to Known Agenda, who had won the Florida Derby in their silks. She is on course to deliver her Maryland-bred foal by Known Agenda in mid-April, then be sent back to Kentucky to breed to a stallion of the partnership's choosing.


